For those of you that do not know, the Harvey Crossing Covenants are legal and binding. The Covenants are put in place to retain monetary value and aesthetic value of all properties in Harvey Crossing. Some of the complaints that I have been getting are: cyclone fencing, metal storage buildings, mail boxes, trees, unauthorized vehicles on the streets, kids trespassing through residents' yards to get to the ponds, kids leaving trash around the ponds, parking vehicles (trailers & boats) in yards, trash in yards, dogs and cats running loose. A word of caution: there are snakes in the ponds. If you allow your children to play around the ponds and/or swim, you are doing so at your own risk. We have ordered signs to place at the ponds and are waiting for them to be printed. You can preview the sign on the website. If there are any problems at the ponds, please contact the Madison County Sheriffs Department immediately.

If you have questions, check your covenants. If you do not have a copy, contact us via the website. Someone will get you a copy. If you see a violation, please contact us via the website.
