Now, on to the ditches. Last month, we told you that we had been working very hard on the ditch situation, pushing for the County to make this top priority on their list. When we sent the newsletter out, we were waiting on the outcome of the bids being placed for the project. It seems that the cost of the ditches was more than they had planned on. Doug Jones, county supervisor, has been working on this issue for some time now, and some members of the Board of Supervisors voted against this. As many of you probably read in the Madison County Herald, they are only going to allot \$58,600, instead of the \$331,000 to fix the problem permanently.

The Harvey Crossing Property Owners' Association has been working on this issue since our formation in 2005. It is very important to the Association that it gets fixed and gets fixed properly. We spoke to Doug during our meeting and he explained what the county would do. They are going to place a green mat that has seeds/vegetation on it that will hold the soil on the sides of the bank. This will help with the erosion problems that we have been facing. **We need you to not use round-up type products on or near these areas.** The work should begin around October and take about a week to complete. Also, the Association is going to hire someone to clean the ditches out twice a year in order to maintain proper drainage. Hopefully this will alleviate all the problems the ditches have caused.
